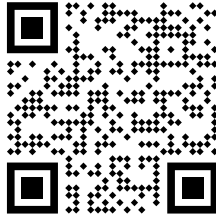

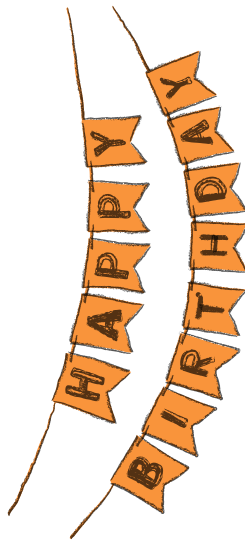

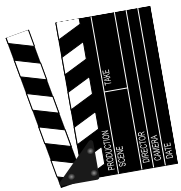

Queen of Hearts Game

RULES:

- To be eligible to play you must be a current resident of VG and purchase at least 1 ticket. Tickets will be sold until the SSS BINGO night, when 1 ticket will be selected. Tickets are \$1 or 6 for \$5. If your ticket is selected you will pick ONE card from the playing board and win \$5. If you pick the Queen of Hearts, you win the JACKPOT! which is 60% of the money collected from the sale of tickets. If you do not pick the Queen of Hearts, the card is placed back on the board, face up, and there will be no payout. There is no limit to the number of tickets purchased. The jackpot based on ticket sales will be updated daily. The other 40% of the ticket money collected will go to the Senior's Social Society
- Write your room number on the half of the ticket you turn in. If you are not present for the drawing, you will be notified and have the opportunity to pick one card prior to the next day's BINGO. If you are not available the next day, a card will be drawn for you. Each week after the drawing, all tickets for that week's drawing will be destroyed. If all but one card is selected, and the Queen of Hearts is not found all cards will be shuffled and replaced on the board and the game will continue.
